

<b>People Soft</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>3 C's</b>	Communications, checklists, and comments are a flexible way to track and analyze correspondence, lists of requirements, and notes about the students, staff, and external organizations in your database.
<b>Academic Advisement Report</b>	PeopleSoft's Campus Solutions Degree Audit module.
<b>Academic Career</b>	Consolidation of application types into careers. Credit, Clock, Non-Credit, Continuing Workforce Education (CWE), & Professional Development (PD)
<b>Academic Plan</b>	Examples- 1108, 2149, 5604, etc. Note: we did not change our plan numbers.
<b>Academic Program</b>	Examples-Bachelor Program (BACH), Associate Degree-Non Financial Aid Eligible (2YNFA), etc.
<b>Academic Requirements</b>	Graduation rules that the student must follow to successfully complete their academic objectives.
<b>Admit Type</b>	A designation used to distinguish First-Time-In-College from in college from transfer students, etc.
<b>Advising Notes</b>	A summary of an academic advising session. Advising notes can only be accessed in the Advisee Student Center by those with the appropriate security.
<b>Campus Community</b>	Where biographical and demographic person data is stored. Ex. Name, address, phone number, residency, etc.
<b>Checklist / To Do List</b>	A list of items that the student needs to complete for enrollment, residency, financial aid, etc .
<b>Citizenship</b>	A person's citizenship status in the USA.
<b>Class Number (4 digits)</b>	A number assigned to a class for a specific term. Class numbers repeat each term, so the same class number may be assigned to a different course in another term.
<b>Class Scheduling</b>	Creation of scheduled classes.
<b>Clock</b>	Clock hour programs.
<b>Comments</b>	Notes about student transactions. Access to comments are based on security.
<b>Course Catalog</b>	Course information.
<b>Course ID</b>	The unique six-digit, auto-generated system number that serves as a serial number to uniquely identify a course throughout its entire history.
<b>Unit</b>	The college credit or clock hour a student earns for completing a class.
<b>Enrollment Appointment</b>	A time period for which you are eligible to register for courses prior to Open Enrollment. Enrollment appointments will follow the same pattern as our current registration windows each semester.

<b>Effective Date</b>	A method of dating information in PeopleSoft applications. By using effective dates, you don't delete values; you enter a new value with a current effective date.
<b>EMPLID</b>	Unique identifier for each person (student and employee) entered into PeopleSoft.
<b>National ID</b>	Social Security Number.
<b>Role &amp; Row Level Security</b>	Role: Security for specific functions and access to specific pages in Campus Solution. Row: Some pages require additional access besides a role in order to view and/or update data. This is referred to as row-level security.
<b>Search/Match</b>	A feature that enables you to search for and identify duplicate records in the database.
<b>Service Indicators</b>	Indicates services that may be either withheld or provided to an individual. Negative service indicators indicate holds that prevent the individual from receiving specified services. Positive service indicators designate special services that are provided to the individual.
<b>Service Impact</b>	An action triggered by a Service Indicator. For example, a Service Indicator that reflects non-payment of account balances by a student may result in a Service Impact that prohibits registration for classes.
<b>Student Groups</b>	Track student membership in various groups within an academic institution, so students of any program or career can be associated with the same group.
