

Students in non-degree-seeking plans may also have an academic advisement report (AAR) listing their plan's Academic Requirements based on their specific effective term. If the College wants the students in a particular plan to be able to enroll in courses, then that non-degree-seeking plan will have an AAR, which will maximize a student's opportunity to independently enroll in courses whenever possible. These students need an academic advisement report to be able to enroll by "My Requirements" in the student portal. On the other hand, certain non-degree-seeking plans like Dual Enrollment (3408) will not have an AAR built because the students need to enroll for courses through their Dual Enrollment Coordinators.

An AAR for a non-degree-seeking student will lack many of the features that are standard on a typical AAR, such as residency, GPA, and defined requirements that must be met to satisfy an area. The AAR does use the same structure for set up, so there are some similarities. See example below.

### **Viewing a Non-Degree-Seeking Academic Advisement Report (AAR)**

The steps to view a non-degree-seeking AAR are the same as those used to view an Academic Advisement Report. In either the Student Services Center or the Advisor Center, Academic Requirements are available for review in the My Academics dropdown list. See the document for "Viewing an Academic Advisement Report" for additional details on using the Advisor Center for this purpose. Keep in mind that viewing AARs requires that an employee's security be set up with permission to access this content.
