Correction Status –The possible Correction Statuses include “Send,” “Sent,” “Accepted,” “Rejected,” and “Don’t Send.”

- **Send** – This file is ready to send to the Department of Education
- **Sent** – This will be the status when the correction has been sent from the College
- **Accepted** – If this is the status the correction has been accepted by Department of Education
- **Rejected** - If this is the status the correction has been rejected by Department of Education
- **Don’t Send** – If this correction status is selected, then the EFC Status is changed from Official to Unofficial. This status may be selected if the processor mistakenly added a row and they may choose “Don’t Send” because they may not want the correction to be sent to Department of Education.
