


Viewing SAP

You can see SAP history by clicking through each row on the SAP status screen.

Navigation: Main Menu>Financial Aid>Satisfactory Academic Progress > Maintain Student SAP Status



Max Attempted Units – PeopleSoft displays attempted hours rather than percentages. If the student went over the 150% rule (i.e. has more than 91 hours), the status will be "OVER."

Cumulative Earned Units – This GPA is different from the cumulative GPA calculated by Student Records. Financial Aid takes into account the student's entire course history. Financial Aid also has plans to modify the system to start counting repeats and multiple attempts.

Current Units Attempted – These are the hours that the student has earned. This number should be the same as the Cumulative Earned Units.

Cumulative Units Attempted – This is the number of hours that have been attempted. When you divide the Current Units Attempted by the Cumulative Units Attempted, you will get the Cumulative earned units percentage.

Severity – Whether or not the student has failed SAP is dependent upon the level of severity of each SAP requirement. The highest level of severity will trump everything else. For example, if a student has a "MEET" status on both Minimum Cumulative GPA and Cumulative Earned Units, but an "OVER" status on Max Attempted Units, the student will Fail SAP. This is because the severity of the Max Attempted Units is higher than the other two areas.
