Before coming on campus, complete a self-check on the FSCJ SAFE App

- **1.** In the last 14 days, have you cared for or have close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19?
- **2.** In the last 10 days, has a health care professional advised you to get tested for COVID-19, or have you had a positive COVID-19 test within the last 10 days?
- **3.** Have you had any of the following symptoms in the past 24 hours that you cannot attribute to another condition: Fever (100.4 F or greater) or chills; cough; shortness of breath or difficulty breathing; fatigue; muscle or body aches; headache; recent onset of loss of taste or smell; sore throat; nausea or vomiting, diarrhea?
- **4.** Are you currently experiencing a new fever (100.4 F or higher), or a sense of having a fever?
- **5.** Have you had any of the following symptoms in the past 24 hours that are not related to allergies: sinus congestion; runny nose?



The purpose of this self-screening

is to help you make decisions about seeking appropriate medical care. It is not intended for the diagnosis or treatment of disease or other conditions, including COVID-19.
