What is FSCJ ACCESS

- A program that is designed to obtain the lowest possible price for adopted materials (digital content) for the students and make those materials available to students when the Canvas shell opens.
 - How is this possible?
 - Price of materials are built into price for the class.
 - This results in very high sell through rates.
 - This allows us to secure the guaranteed lowest possible price.
 - Students have the opportunity to opt-out (and back in) at any time all the way up to the close of the drop without penalty (add/drop) window.

Expansion of the FSCJ ACCESS Program

- In the Spring of 2021 we launched the FSCJ ACCESS pilot project.
 - In the pilot program we had:
 - A total of 17 classes.
 - Total duplicated enrollments was 260.
 - Total savings to participants was \$14,045.49.
- This past Spring Term 2025:
 - Total of 1,527 classes.
 - Total duplicated enrollments was 29,826.
 - Total Savings to participants was \$909,991.26

Participating in FSCJ ACCESS

- As you are aware, in the Fall term 2025 we launched with BibliU as our new courseware provider.
- The choice to participate in FSCJ ACCESS is made at the point of adoption.
- If you select a digital product. Either digital courseware or a digital book (eBook) you are automatically enrolled in FSCJ ACCESS.
- When new classes are scheduled, we initially schedule as tentative so that faculty can complete the adoption and if digital we can get the ACCESS fee attached before we open the class for enrollment.
- The only time this will not be true is if the class has enrollment and shifts to into a more expensive digital product inside 40 days prior to the start of the term.

Participating in FSCJ ACCESS

- Each Term, as soon as Academic Operations receives the finalized list from BibliU, we will send an email out to all Faculty to verify FSCJ ACCESS participation status for that term.
 - If you believe your status is incorrect please immediately respond to that email.
- This occurs around 50 days prior to the start of the term.
- **We target entry into program 45 days prior to the start of each session.**
- **We lock entry into program 40 days prior to the start of each session.**
- **A class that is in ACCESS and shifts to a later session can stay in ACCESS.**
- **Now when we schedule new classes we initially schedule as tentative to allow time to get the fee attached if it is in ACCESS prior to opening enrollment.**
- **You can exit the program at any time.**
- We schedule these informational sessions the week prior to the start of each term.

Things You Need to Know About FSCJ ACCESS

- Students who opt-out do not lose access to materials until after the NA window closes.
 - This is important to make sure the students are aware
- VA students using Chapter 31 (Voc Rehab) are opted out automatically and they will need to purchase their materials using their PO (standard practice).
- Students using FLDOE Voc Rehab will need to opt-out since they must follow the book voucher process as well.
- There is a committee that oversees FSCJ ACCESS. Although we have been running ACCESS for over five years, that committee continues to meet every other week.

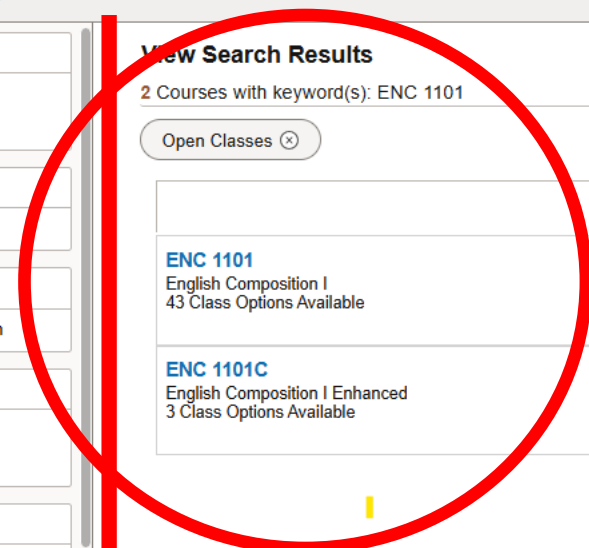

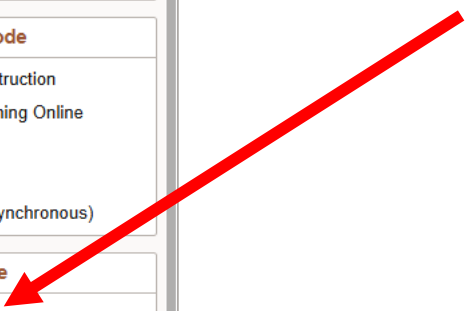

Securing A Hard Copy of the Digital Textbook

- Generally speaking: If the student has an e-book, a digital textbook only, and they desire a hard copy of the textbook, the student should opt-out and secure a hard copy.
- Generally speaking: If the student is using digital courseware they can “upgrade” to add a hard copy through their logins with McGraw, Cengage, Pearson, etc. When they are logged in, they can choose the option for a hard copy. There will be an upcharge, but the hard copy would be mailed to the student’s home.

- Although the growth of FSCJ ACCESS stalled as we shifted over to BibliU, we expect ACCESS growth to pick back up for the Fall Term 2026 and beyond.
